Visibility	Children & Adults	Low	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Brighter coloured rope and string used if possible otherwise high visibility tape attached to increase visibility.</li> </ul>		Low
Tripping	Children Staff	Low	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Bright coloured rope or tape used as described above.</li> <li>When using rope participants will be taught to avoid placing them where people can trip over them.</li> <li>Participants taught how to store and carry rope and string.</li> </ul>		Low
Catching neck	Children Staff	Low	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>As above.</li> <li>Avoid putting ropes or strings at head height wherever possible.</li> </ul>		
Entanglement	Children Staff	Low	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Ropes and string to be stored and carried correctly.</li> <li>Any excess rope or string to be secured.</li> </ul>		Low
Rope Burn	Children Staff	Low	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Gloves available when rope is being used to pull something.</li> </ul>		Low
